

Financial Assistance with Tuition Sources and Process

Sources of funding prior to receiving Adopt-a-student funds:

1. FACTS grants administered through the Catholic Foundation.
Go to: www.thecatholicfoundation.org
2. Maloof scholarship, also administered through the Catholic Foundation.
Family must live in Bernalillo County.

3. Funds held by each school. (Some funds are forwarded to each school from the Archbishop's School Fund Dinner.)

4. Educate NM; these scholarships are awarded to New Mexico families who are below certain income limits.

Adopt-a-Student Funds (Process)

Applicants; please write a letter addressed to "Superintendent of Catholic Schools".

Information required within the letter from Applicants:

1. Include in the letter the student name, age, grade (for the year funds are being requested), and the school at which the student is enrolled.
(Before any funds are awarded, enrollment will be verified).
2. Attach to the letter a FACTS tuition aid application.

CYFD License
